1. Cross border trade:

Services delivery from the Netherlands to another country;

- distance consultancy advice,
- e-learning,
- supply chain coordination from a control tower in the Netherlands

2. Consumption abroad:

Supply of services of the Netherlands to a service customer abroad;

- Foreign students studying in the Netherlands,
- Foreign shippers without a Dutch establishment outsourcing their logistics to Dutch service providers

3. Commercial presence:

Services provided by Dutch service suppliers in another country;

- Foreign subsidiary of Dutch logistic service providers providing planning and transport services in that region

4. Presence natural persons:

Services provided by Dutch supplier by presence of natural abroad;

- Technical assistance in port development projects,
- Capacity building/ education delivered abroad

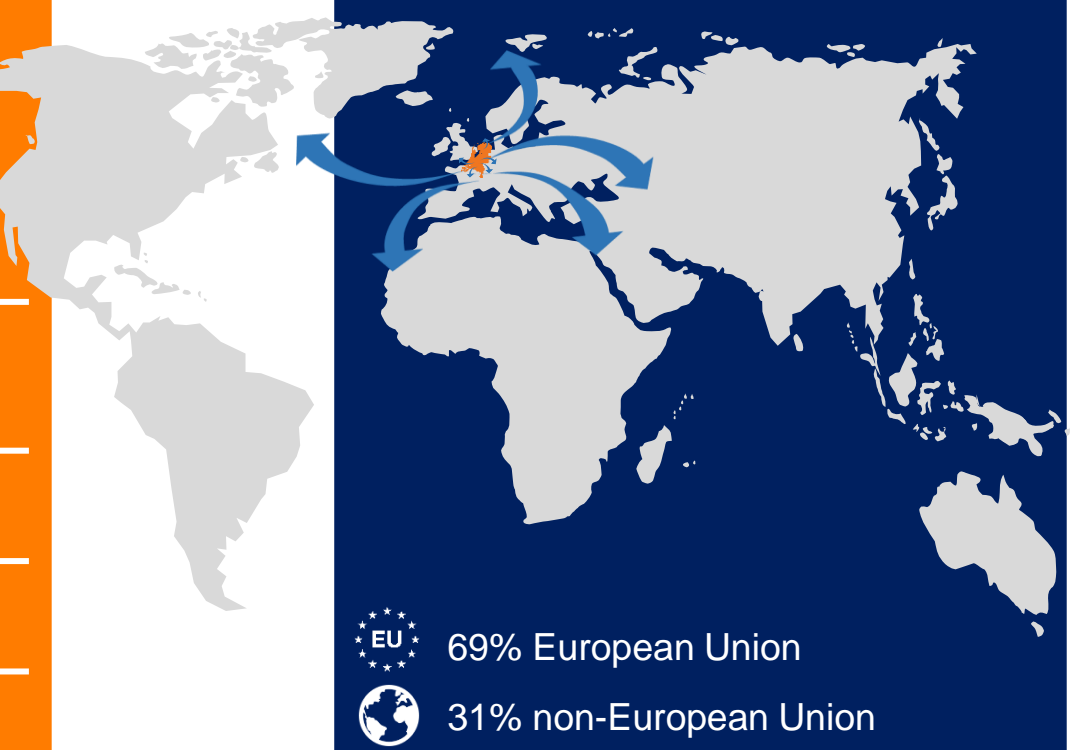
